## **Materials List:**

Winsor Newton designer gouache or M. Graham gouache Note: Holbein acryla gouache is NOT what we are using, but will be discussed.

## Gouache in tubes:

- Permanent White
- Cadmium yellow
- Yellow ochre
- Cadmium red
- Alizarin crimson
- Spectrum violet
- Ultramarine blue
- Cerulean blue
- Burnt umber
- Burnt sienna

140 lb cold press watercolor block (any size up to 9 x12), Or Cottonwood Arts laminated cold press boards (available online at cottonwoodarts.com)

Synthetic watercolor/acrylic brushes: #6, #8 pointed round, 1/2 & 1 inch flats; selection of various size brushes for detail work (typically in the #2, #4). Bring what you have and we can make them work!

Stawet sealable wet palette with sponge for keeping paint wet (8x 10in) - suggestions: Mijello airtight plastic pallete, or Meeden airtight plastic pallete. These are good inexpensive options.

Cups for water (large yogurt containers work well)

Spray water bottle

Roll of paper towels
