## MATERIALS LIST: HEAD PAINTING WORKSHOP

- 1. Odorless Turpenoid or Gamsol
- 2. Viva paper towels or rags
- 3. (1) 11 x 14 inch canvas's or canvas panel.

Note: I recommend toning your canvas to get rid of the white. Traditionally called "imprimatura".

If your using gesso primed canvas, then mix gesso with a little bit of raw umber to achieve an off white, sort of a crème grey color and then apply to canvas. You want to achieve an average mid-tone.

If your using oil primed canvas, then I suggest a mixture of raw umber and white thinned with turpenoid applied with brush, then rubbed with a rag to achieve an even tone to the canvas. You want to achieve an average gray mid-tone. If applying oil, allow this tone to dry at least 3 days, so you'll have to prepare in advance. (see photo provided)

4. Brushes: Bristle Brights (short) or Filberts:

Sizes 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8. (I use the standard Utrecht Standard natural Curve Bristle Brights and also use a synthetic combination Silver Bristlon 1901 Bright) I also recommend various sable or synthetic brushes. I use the Rose Mary brand sable brushes. My favorites are the Short Flat Ser 274 in sizes 2,3,4.

- 5. Palette knife for mixing and possible applying paint.
- 6. Brush cleaning jar for cleaning oil brushes. This will be filled with turpenoid or gamsol to clean your brushes.
  - 7. One or two small metal cups to hold turpenoid and one for linseed oil
  - 8. Linseed oil. (500 ml)
  - 9. Wooden Palette approx 12" x 16 or smaller (9" round wooden palette available at Aaron Bros 3.99)

Apply sealer on wooden palette. I can apply Shellac or an oil rub.

## 10 .Recommended oil paints:

- 1. Lead or Flake White (Rublev). Titanium White (Winsor Newton) is OK.
- 2. Yellow Ocre 37ml (Winsor Newton)
- 3. Cad Yellow (Winsor Newton) Optional
- 4. Cad Orange (Winsor Newton) Optional
- 5. Terra Rosa 37ml (Winsor Newton)
- 6. Burnt Sienna (Winsor Newton)
- 7. Burnt Umber (Winsor Newton)
- 8. Raw Umber (Winsor Newton)
- 9. Ivory Black (Winsor Newton)
